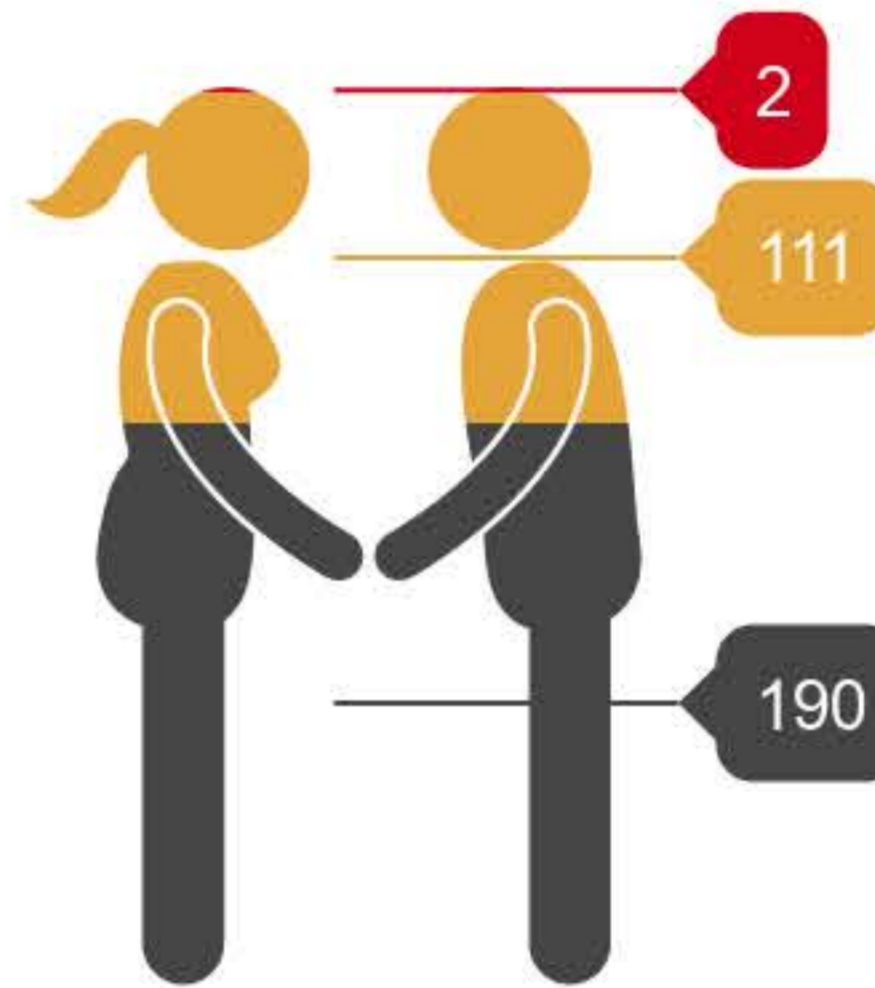

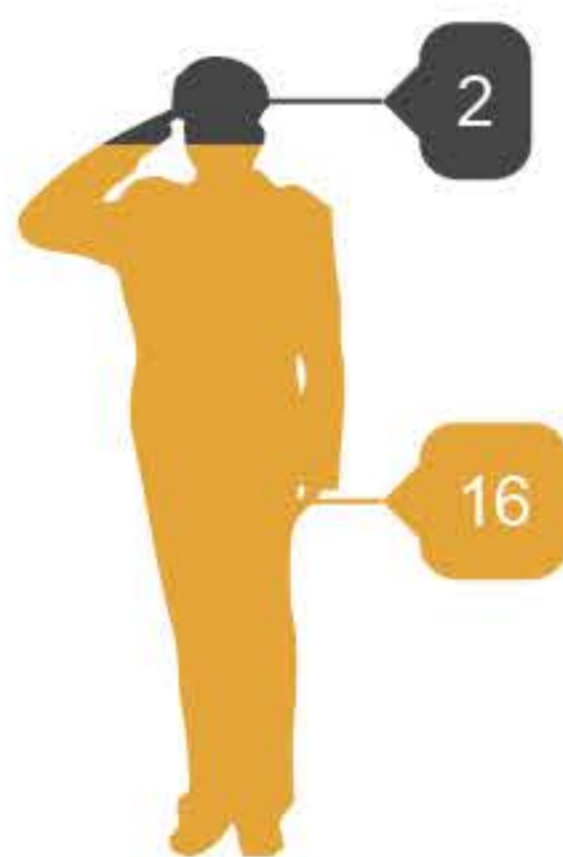

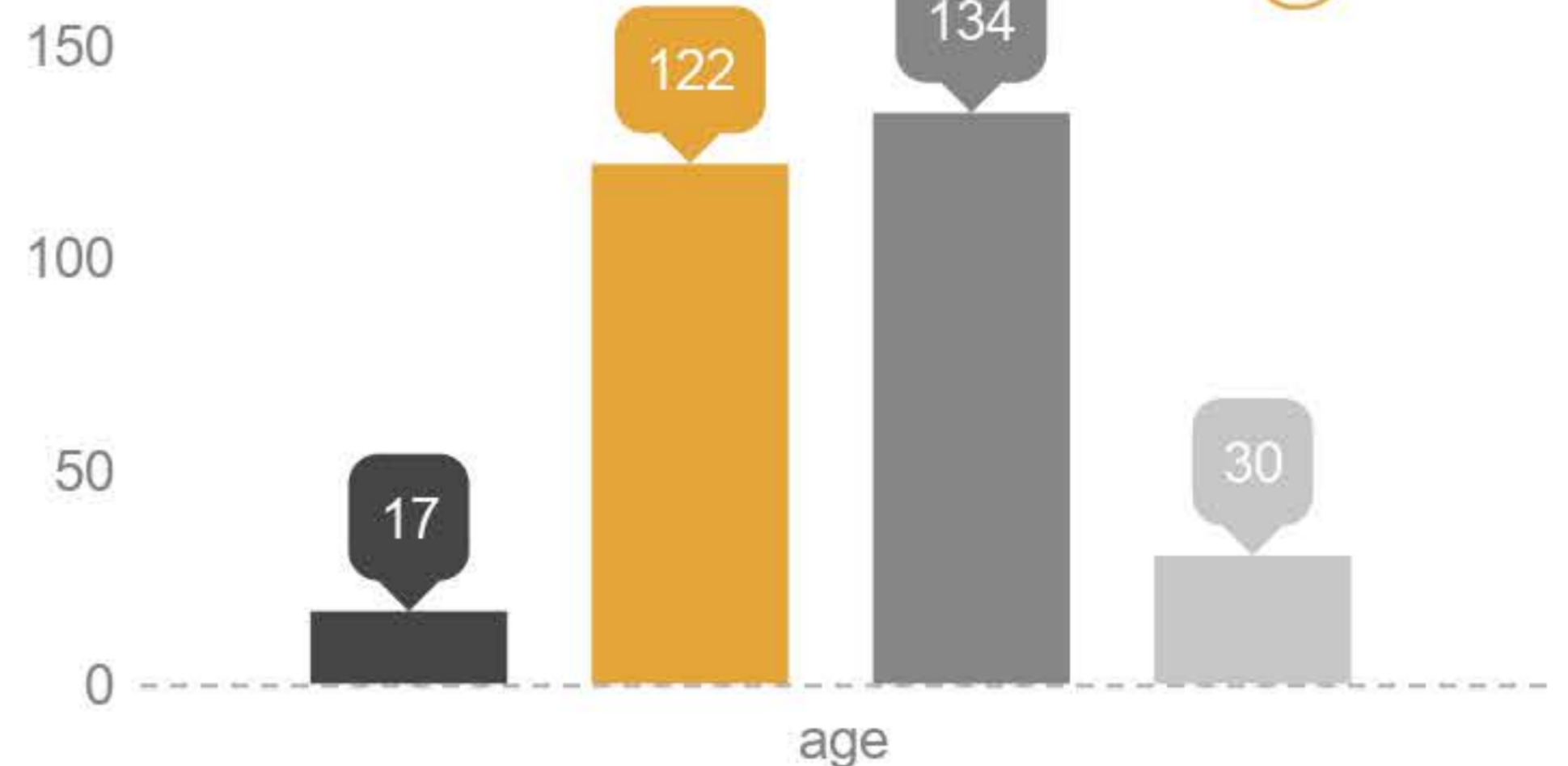

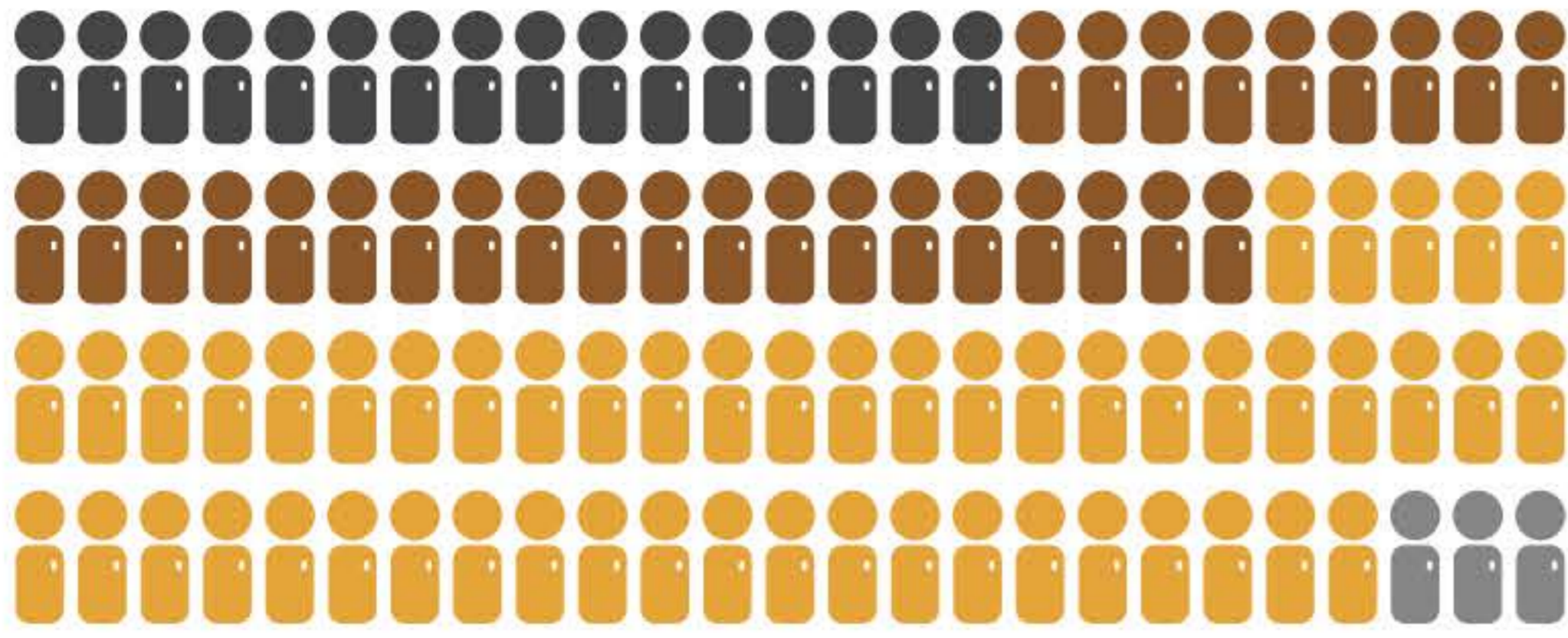

current sleeping arrangement



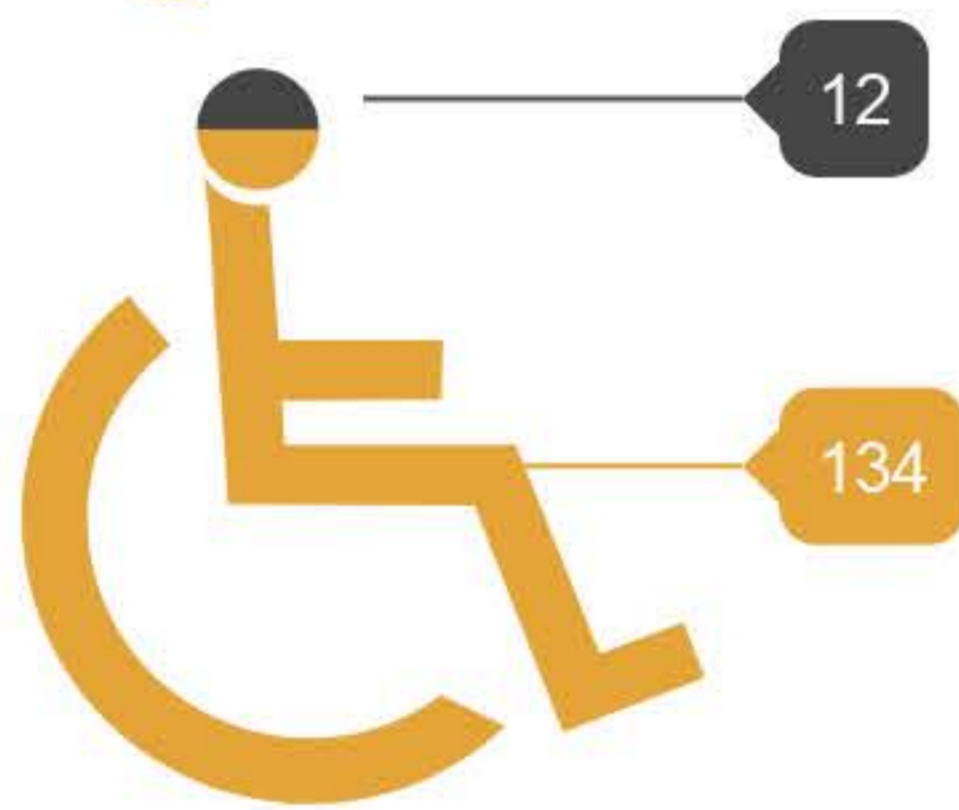

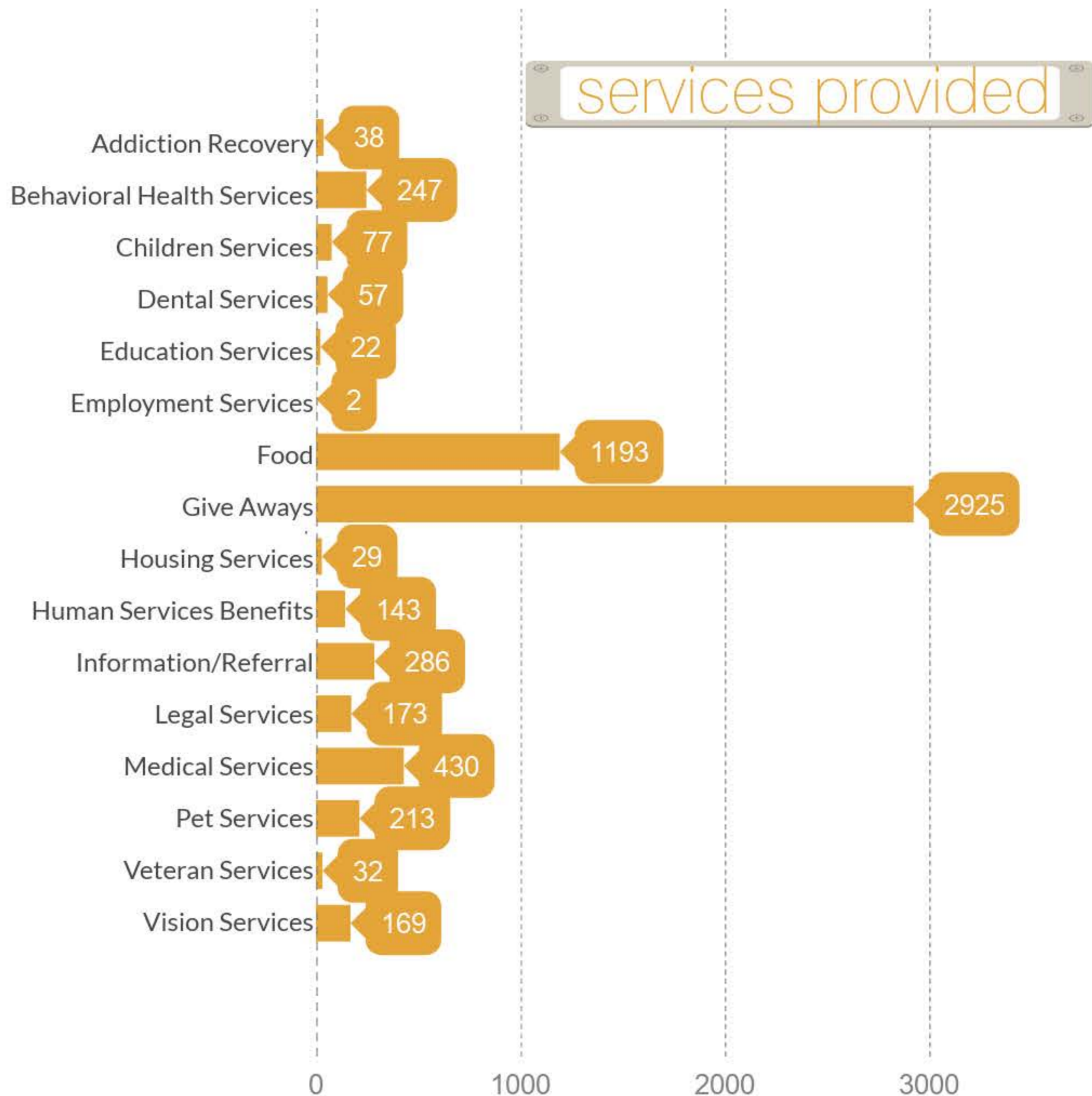
